Our hall is adorned with a magnificent Christmas tree. Thank you so much to Shelley at Wheatley Christmas trees who kindly donated to us.

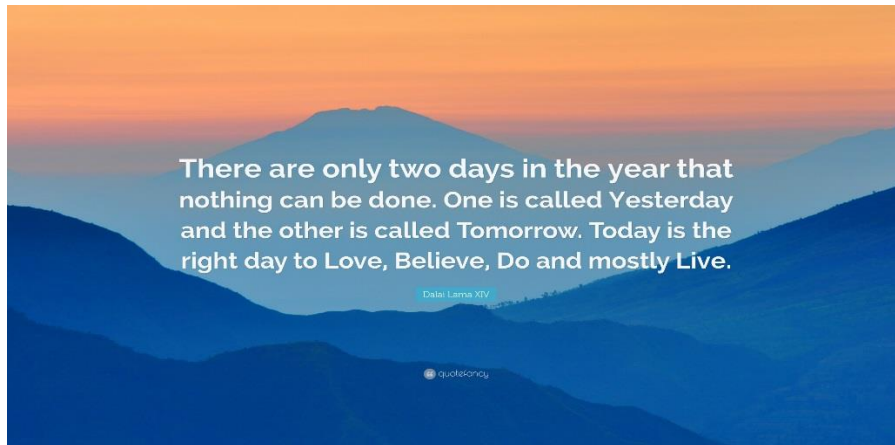
Reminder
