Rachel has been with us since we started. Her many achievements include, regular work experience at the Eatwell Café in Barton, SOFEA (food bank), Vana Farm and serving students and staff in the Enterprise Jacket Potato Café, developing walking for exercise and enjoyment and her confidence in an increasing variety of environments, including, most recently, a Ball at St Hilda's College.

Rachel is moving onto Lufton College in Somerset where she will follow an individualised study programme, to match her needs, personal decisions and future aspirations. Rachel will be enjoying a course that will enhance her catering skills, develop her life skills and offer work experience opportunities.

Oli also started at Endeavour when we first opened. Oli has especially impressed staff with his ability to independently complete familiar practical tasks, for example, watering the circle class vegetable borders, art and crafts at school, wood work projects at Penny Hooks Farm and looking after their livestock. Oli has also increased his confidence to access different environments and to make his voice heard. This term Oli told us he wanted to go to see a lizard and helped to plan a visit to a local specialist reptile shop where he was able to handle a Bearded Dragon. Oli loves to be outdoors and has shared many happy walks in Shotover Country Park with peers and staff.

Next year he will be starting at Sheiling College in Dorset. There Oli will follow a hands-on curriculum with learning opportunities that match his interests. He will be enjoying a person centred curriculum focused around his woodwork and his gardening talents. The college is in a beautiful natural setting giving Oli easy access to work experience and recreation in the outdoors he so loves.

Luke T, also an 'Endeavour original', is moving on. Luke loves watching and interacting with others. He has worked especially well in intensive interaction sessions and is a pleasure to spend time with. Luke's achievements include, weekly work experience at Vana Farm, where he independently follows routines to feed and water animals, fantastic drumming sessions, gaining the confidence to mount independently from the ramp in horse riding sessions and recently enthusiastic joining in with Flamenco dancing. Luke has also worked well communicating with Proloquo to go on the iPad to make requests and choices.

Luke W joined Endeavour in May 2015. This term Luke has especially impressed staff on community visits. On Fridays he has accessed various local cultural and recreational activities with peers. These have included visits to The University Museum, the Botanic Gardens, libraries, OXSRAD gym, bowling and mini golf. Luke has contributed to Jacket Potato Café through weekly preparation of salad, receiving payment, giving change and charming customers with his smile.

Luke T and Luke W will both be joining MAP College in Abingdon. There they will follow a highly individualised programme focusing on developing life skills. Learning will take place both on campus and through accessing activities and work experiences in the community.

It is time for them to fly the nest and move into adulthood. We will miss them greatly and thank them for the joy that they have brought to our hearts every day. We look forward to hearing about all of the amazing journeys that they have in the future and will hopefully see them at some of our whole school events in the future.

We welcome new staff in September: Anna Shenton, Allan Taylor, Wendy Heycock, and Ella Peysner.


Summer Holiday
