Families First Award

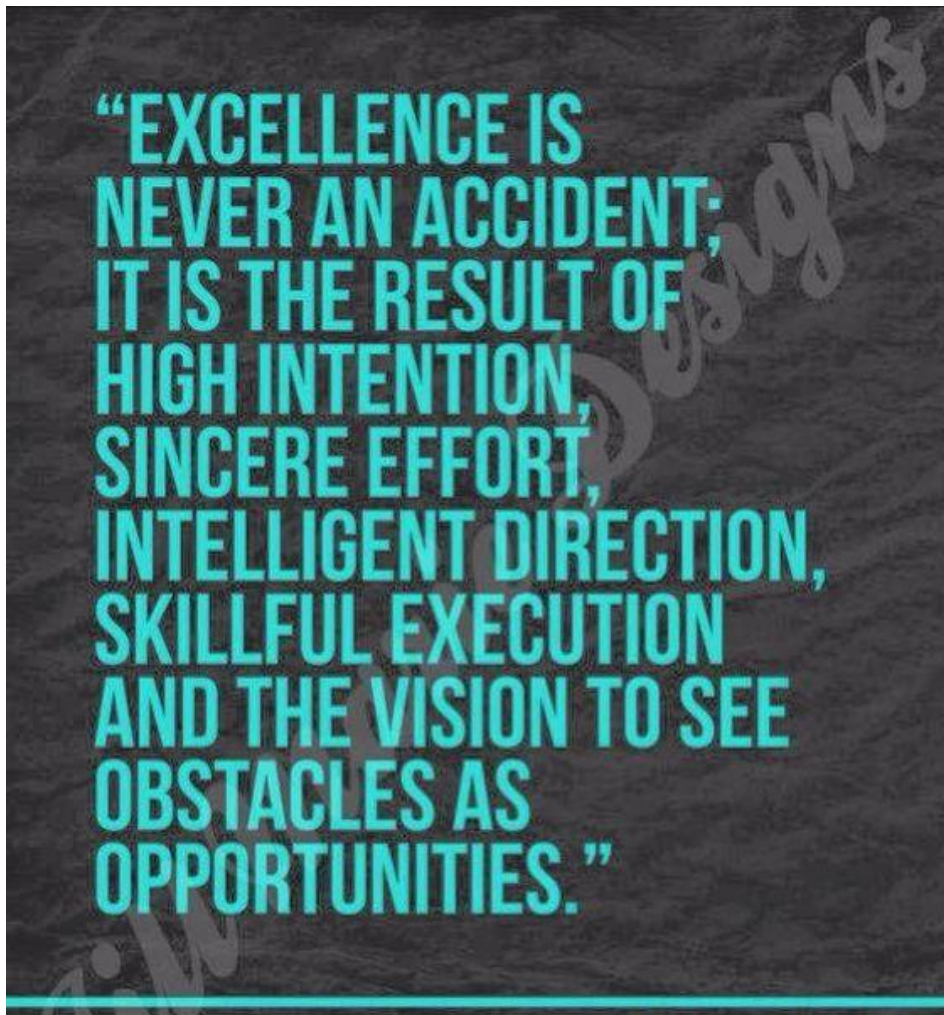
