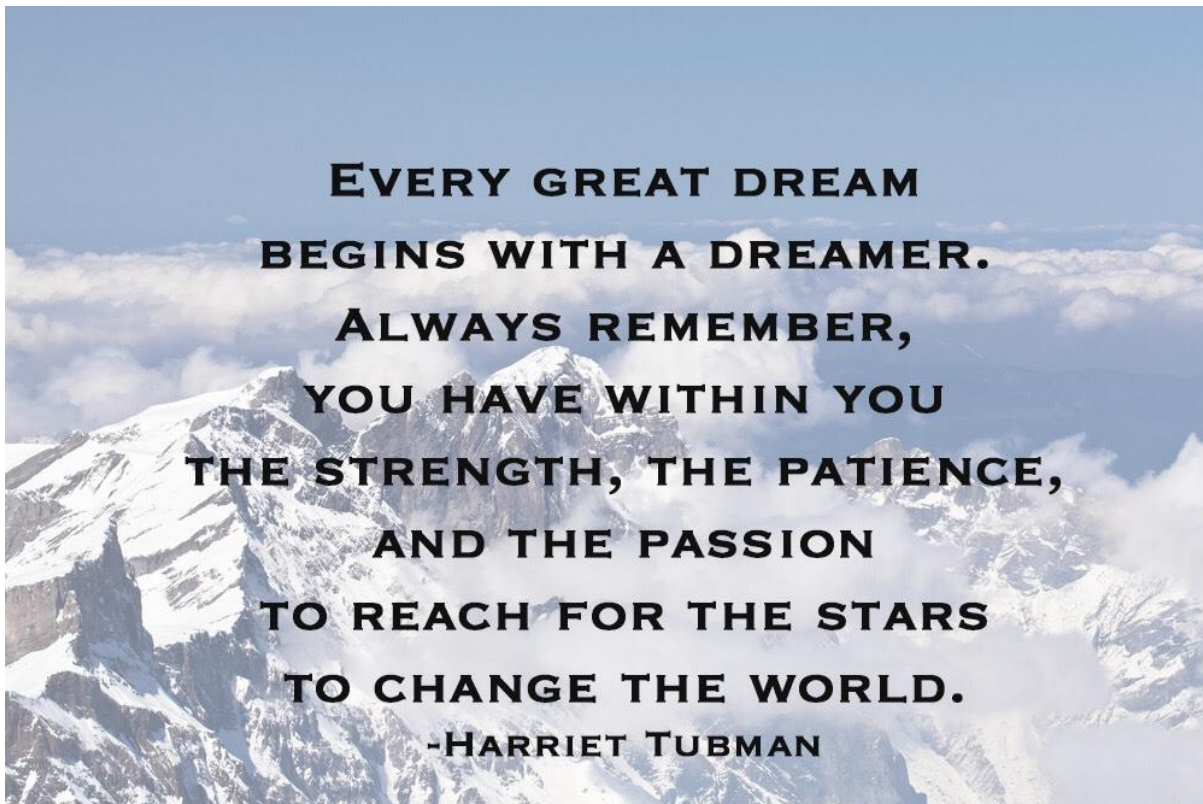
Next week we look forward to Holi and St Patrick Day celebrations across school.
